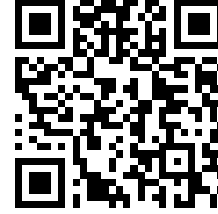

<p>B.Pharm</p>	<p>The Registrar North Maharashtra University P B No Umavi Nagar Jalgaon Maharashtra</p>	<p>10.1 The latest information on record including the following facts were placed and considered.</p> <p>a) Judgement dt.5.3.2020 passed by Honble Supreme Court of India in Transfer Petitions (Civil) Nos. 87-101 of 2014.</p> <p>b) Councils mail dt.25.3.2020 seeking information in pursuance of Honble Supreme Court judgement dt.5.3.2020.</p> <p>c) reply dt.1.5.2020 received from the institution.</p> <p>10.2 The matter was threadbarely discussed and it was noted that -</p> <p>a) the Honble Supreme Court of India in its judgment dt.5.3.2020 has held that in the field of Pharmacy Education and more particularly so far as the recognition of degrees and diplomas of Pharmacy Education is concerned, the Pharmacy Act, 1948 shall prevail. The norms and regulations set by the PCI and other specified authorities under the Pharmacy Act would have to be followed by the concerned institutions imparting education for degrees and diplomas in Pharmacy, including the norms and regulations with respect to increase and/or decrease in intake capacity of the students and the decisions of the PCI shall only be followed by the institutions imparting degrees and diplomas in Pharmacy.</p> <p>b) the said judgment further directed the concerned institutions who increased their intake capacity as approved by AICTE and their increase in intake capacity was not approved by PCI, shall apply afresh for increase in intake capacity and/or evening shift for the next academic year within a period of four weeks from the date of judgment and their cases for increase in intake capacity and/or applications for recognition and/or applications for approval of the course or evening shift shall be considered by the PCI in accordance with the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and rules and regulations framed therein and the norms prescribed by the PCI.</p> <p>c) pursuant to above judgment, the PCI vide mail dt.25.3.2020 sought information from the institution.</p> <p>d) the institution vide letter dt.1.5.2020 submitted the reply.</p>	<p>Approved</p>

		<p>10.4 In view of the judgment dt.5.3.2020 passed by Honble Supreme Court and statutory provisions of various Education Regulations framed by the PCI u/s 10 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 it was noted and decided as under</p> <p>(B) Regarding B.Pharm Course</p> <p>(a)It was noted that</p> <p>i.with regard to intake in B.Pharm course, Regulation-5. of The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014 mandates that number of admissions in B.Pharm course shall be as prescribed by the PCI from time to time.</p> <p>ii.the admissions to B.Pharm Course are restricted to 100 as prescribed under the Scheme framed under Regulation 9(1) of the said Regulations.</p> <p>iii.Honble Supreme Court in its judgement dt 05.03.2020 has upheld that norms, standards and regulations with regard to intake capacity of students and decision of PCI shall only be followed.</p> <p>(b)In view of above it was decided to grant approval to B.Pharm course upto 2020-2021 academic session for 100 admissions.</p> <p>10.5 With regard to the already admitted students, it was decided to process the matter as per the judgment dated 5/3/2020 passed by Honble Supreme Court of India.</p>
