## PATENT FOR 'CAPSULE FILLING MACHINE' APPROVED BY GOVT. OF INDIA .

Patel Pharmacy have successfully filed a patent for a Capsule Filling Machine, which has now been approved by the Government of India. The approval process took approximately one and a half years. ## ₹EIGHT-LAKH GRANT FOR RESEARCH ON WOMEN'S HEALTH AWARENESS

THREE PROFESSORS FROM SHIRPUR PHARMACY COLLEGE SECURED THE PRESTIGIOUS GRANT



**SHIRPUR.** Dr. Kalpesh Patil, Prof. Hemakshi Chaudhary, and Prof. Snehal Bhavsar from R.C. Patel Pharmacy College in Shirpur have been awarded a grant of rupees eight lakh under the Rajiv Gandhi Science and Technology Scheme for Research. Their research is focussed on various health challenges faced by women. The grant has been approved by North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.

Dr. Kalpesh Patil received ₹2,30,000 for his research on *Development of Digital Knowledge Base "Jagruti" to Facilitate Menstrual Hygiene and Promote Reproductive Health Among Rural Maharashtra*. Dr. Patil serves as the principal investigator, with Dr. C.R. Patil and Dr. Shitalkumar Zhambad as co-investigators. Prof. Hemakshi Chaudhary has been awarded ₹4,00,000 for her research on *Investigation of Early Predictors of Migraine and PCOD in Adolescent Girls from Tribal Regions of Shirpur*. Prof. Chaudhary is the principal investigator, with Prof. Snehal Bhavsar as co-investigator. This study will focus on PCOD and migraines in adolescent girls.

Prof. Snehal Bhavsar received ₹2,00,000 for her research on *Formulation and Evaluation of Essential Oil-Containing Nanoemulgel and Anti-Inflammatory Treatment for Candidiasis*. Prof. Bhavsar is the principal investigator, with Prof. Rajeshwarya Patil as co-investigator. Additionally, Prof. Bhavsar won the first prize at the University Level Research Festival and has over 10 research publications, along with an Indian patent.
